Rev. Dr. Keith A. Troy is the second of four sons of the Reverend and Mrs. Leon L. Troy, Sr. He was born in Toledo, Ohio and attended Warren, Ohio public schools. He and Mrs. Brenda Troy have three daughters, Myeshia, Tiffane', Shan-eece, two sons, Andre' and Kendall. He received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from Morehouse College in Atlanta, Georgia, where he majored in Religion and minored in Education. He earned his Master of Divinity Degree from Colgate Rochester/Bexley Hall/Crozer Seminary in Rochester, New York, and his Doctor of Ministry Degree from United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio.

Rev. Troy has been the Pastor of the New Salem Missionary Baptist Church in Columbus, Ohio Since, October, 1983, Under his Columbus leadership, the congregation has grown to 4,500 members and purchased a new sanctuary, the former Baptist Temple in 1988. The church burned the mortgage on October 20, 1996. He has also led the church in a vision of multiple staff and ministry and developed many programs for children, youth, adults and seniors.
