After the death of Jesus, the assignment of His followers to spread the Good News of His death and resurrection was initially carried out exclusively among the Jews





The Jewish movement to follow Jesus was not called Christianity but rather "The Way" from Isaiah 40:3





Acts 8, 9, 10 records the beginning of the "Gentile Mission"





Because The Way was seen as a progression from within Judaism, there was the belief that you had to become a Jew first and adhere to the laws of Moses before you could become a follower of Jesus Christ





Judaizers = Jewish Christians who argued that all believers had to commit and conform to the laws of Moses in the OT – especially <u>circumcision</u>





Is Christianity a religion, defined by adherence to rituals and laws, or is it a relationship with God by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone?





Disagreements, when handled the right way, can be opportunities to discern and experience God in new ways
