YHWH

- ▶ Jewish scribes refused to add vowels because the name was never to be spoken lest it be profaned
- ▶ When they came upon it in scripture, most times they substituted it with Adonai

Jehovah

YAHWEH

Adonai + YHWH

YaHoWaH

Jehovah Jireh

- ▶ The Lord will Provide
- ▶ Genesis 22:14 (22:1-14)
- ▶ Provision is translated from Hebrew into the verb “to see”

Jehovah Rapha

- ▶ The Lord Who Heals You
- ▶ Exodus 15:26 (Exodus 15:22-26)
- ▶ Rapha- The root word for heal “to fix” or “to mend”
- ▶ Rapha is used up to 60 times in the Old Testament each time meaning “to restore” or “to cure”

Jehovah Nissi

- ▶ The Lord is my Banner
- ▶ Exodus 17:15 (Exodus 8-15)
- ▶ Banner- a bare staff with a metal ornament used to identify an army's tribe or nation in battle

Jehovah Qadash

- ▶ The Lord who sanctifies
- ▶ Leviticus 20:8
- ▶ Sanctification- “to consecrate” or “to make holy”
- ▶ Genesis 2:3
 - ▶ Then God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done.
