Themes and Theology of Galilean Ministry

The Ability to Recognize Jesus as the Christ

In Luke's Gospel those who should recognize Jesus don't, and those who shouldn't do

 Should: People from Nazareth, Religious Leaders, Disciples (8:22-25), John (7:18-23)

 Shouldn't: Unclean Spirits 4:34 & 8:28, Roman Centurion 7:1-10, Sinful Woman 7:36-50, Wind and Waves 8:22-25, The Rejection and Acceptance of Jesus

- Nazareth 4:16-30, why?
- ▶ 4:42-44
- Jairus Ruler of the Synagogue
- Herod 9:7-9

Pharisees, Scribes, Lawyers – reject because of who Jesus hung with, His violation of their interpretation of the Sabbath laws, Forgiveness of sins

Jesus and the Outsiders

Opens the grace of God to non-Jews

Exposes our ability to be offended by God's love upon those whom we did not approve

Jesus and the Outsiders

Ate, called, and embraced those religiously rejected Highlighted sinful woman Was touched by unclean woman ✓ Touched Leper ✓ Called a tax-collector \checkmark Showed that Demoniac \neq Immoral

Messianic Secrecy

Most prevalent in the Gospel of Mark, but also seen in Luke, is the curious command of Jesus to keep his identity secret:

- ✓ 4:35, 4:41, 5:14,
- ✓ Purpose of parables 8:9,10
- ✓ John 7:20-22
- ✓ Disciples 9:21, 9:45 v. 9:28-36
- ✓ Legion 8:39

Messianic Secrecy

Naming = Authority over Jesus refuses to be led away by the applause of people People's desire v. awareness of God's purpose

Messianic Secrecy

The sign of the Savior ≠ miracles

The messengers did not fit the message (Acts 16:16-18, 19:13-17)

Cross-less confession is powerless The Calling of the Disciples Fishermen 5:1-11 Matthew 5:27-32

Skill v. Obedience
Power of Word
Necessity of Partnership
Recognition of Sins

The Calling of the Disciples

Fishers of men/women Matthew: Progression of discipleship Requires less to believe Complete surrender v. partial obedience (8:19-21; 9:23-27) 4:21
