

## Four-Source Hypothesis



- ► Luke has a sequel Acts
- Addressed to Theophilus, "friend of God"
- Addressed to Greek/Christian audience
- Written by a "third generation" Christian
- Unprecedented presence of women
- "pairing": Lost sheep/Lost coin, (15:4-10); plant mustard seed/ leaven (13:18-21)
- ▶ Luke refers to widows more than any other gospel
- ▶ Women travel with the 12 (8:3)
