





CRITERIA FOR ASBC SENIOR SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Member of ASBC, a minimum of 2 years after receiving the Right Hand of Fellowship
 - 2. Regular worship service attendance
- 3. Active participant (at least 70% of the events) of two on-going ministries, in addition to church worship, during your junior and senior years of high school (Examples of on-going ministries: Awana, Choir, Senior Youth, Ushers, Sunday School, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Liturgical Dance, Youth Drama, and Media)
 - 4. High School Diploma or Equivalent
 - 5. Acceptance into a program of an accredited institution
