Donna Lynn Scott was born October 11, 1962, in Clinton, Oklahoma to the late Jack M. and Shirley O. Scott. She was youngest of seven children.

Donna grew up in Washington, DC and graduated from Dunbar Senior High School in 1980. After graduating from high school, she attended Old Dominion University where she earned her Bachelors of Arts in 1984 and became a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated in the Fall of 1982. Shortly after graduating, Donna was commissioned in the United States Army where she proudly served over 27 years retiring with the rank of Colonel. Before retiring, Donna obtained her Juris Doctor from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1998. She then began her law career as an Assistant District Attorney for Bronx, New York after passing her bar exam on the first attempt. Later, Donna returned home and practiced law in the District of Columbia and Northern Virginia where she resided. In 2020 Donna continued her academic pursuits by attending Duke University School of Divinity, and will be awarded her degree posthumously.

Donna was an active member of many organizations including the Alfred Street Baptist Church where she sang in several church choirs. Donna shared a great love of travel and she saw the world. She was an avid volunteer; most notable was her annual participation with the Cherry Blossom Parade serving as a committee member and planner. Among her many accolades was her admittance to the Supreme Court Bar of Virginia in 2019. Until her illness Donna was an active runner and participated in the Marine Corp Marathon, the Army Navy Ten-Miler and the Cherry Blossom Marathon.

Donna leaves to mourn and cherish her memory four sisters; Rubie B. King, Barbara E. Scott, Denise M. Scott and Romona J. Henson; two sister-in-law's, six nieces, one brother-in-law, five nephews, and a host of great nieces, nephews, aunts and cousins.

Unapologetic, Holding Me Up, Drawing Me Near.

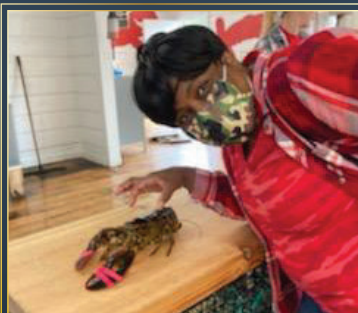
